

PRESCOTT GROUP SOCIETY HOUSE RULES

1. The Prescott Group Society Chase the Ace fundraiser will take place on Thursday evenings at approximately 4:00pm until the ace of spades is drawn. The draw will take place at the Prescott Group Society office located at 3430 Prescott St, Halifax, NS, B3K 4Y4.
2. The Chase the Ace contest is open to any member of the public and ticket sales are restricted to those aged 19 years or older.
3. Ticket sales will be administered by the Prescott Group Society and all draws will be directed by the Prescott Group Society.
4. All tickets for the Chase the Ace will be stub tickets which capture the participant's name and contact information. Tickets will be four colours: 3/\$5 or 12/\$20.
 - (a) There is no limit to the amount of tickets a person can purchase.
 - (b) It is the ticket purchasers' responsibility to complete the ticket contact information and check their tickets at the point of purchase. If there are any ticket discrepancies, errors or concerns they must be brought forward to the Prescott Group Society before the draw.
5. Ticket sales at the Prescott Group Society will run from Friday to Thursday and finish for the week on Thursday at 2:00pm. The draw will be held at the Prescott Group Society office at approximately 4:00pm. Additional selling location(s):
 - (a) Prescott Employment Services office: *7071 Bayers Rd, suite 153* – Finish selling Thursdays at 2:00pm

Prescott Group Society will notify, in writing, to officials from Nova Scotia Alcohol, Gaming, Fuel and Tobacco the ticket selling times for each location and any additional selling locations as these are still to be determined.

6. The weekly contribution of sales will be distributed between the following:
 - (a) **50%** of the week's sales will go to Prescott Group Society
 - (b) **30%** will be added to the jackpot that night.
 - (c) **20%** will be awarded to the winning ticket holder.
7. The first Chase the Ace draw will be conducted with a standard set of 52 playing cards. Each subsequent weekly Chase the Ace draw will use that same deck of cards.
8. The Chase the Ace Jackpot will be seeded at \$2,500.
9. Each Chase the Ace draw will be carried out in accordance with the following procedures and processes:

(a) **Ticket Draw:**

- The ticket draw will be videotaped and stored for the full duration of the license.
- The ticket draw must be done in the presence of no fewer than three witnesses.
- Before the ticket draw, there will be an announcement that states the following:
 - Identifying the number of ticket sales
 - The ticket draw prize (20%)

- The amount added to the jackpot (30%) and if applicable, the new jackpot total.
- The Prescott Group Society staff member that draws the winning ticket will not have any tickets in the draw. They will roll up sleeves or wear short sleeves and show their empty hands prior to handling the tickets.
- The winning number will be verbally announced and visually displayed.
- The winning number will be read out loud a minimum of three times during a 15-minute time frame. The winner will receive the ticket draw prize of 20% if they are present at the time or not.
 - If the winner is physically present within the 15-minute time frame, they will continue to the jackpot draw.
 - If the winner is not physically present but is contacted on the telephone, they can allow Prescott Group Society to or a present designate to choose on their behalf. They will need to give verbal permission, and this information will be recorded.
 - If the winner is not present and we cannot reach the winner by telephone within the 15-minute time frame they forfeit the right to select a card from the deck themselves and a Prescott Group Society staff member will participate in the jackpot draw and choose on behalf of the winner. Any prize not claimed is to be kept for a period of 90 days from the draw date. Should the prize not be claimed at the end of that period a second draw is to be held from the tickets of that draw.
- A record will be kept each week that states the winner of the ticket draw prize and the amount they won.

(b) Jackpot Draw:

- This will occur immediately after the ticket draw.
- The deck of cards will be secured in a sealed envelope and locked in a protected safe. The same deck of cards will be used for each weekly Chase the Ace draw.
- The selection of the card will be videotaped and stored for the full duration of the license.
- The selection of the card must be done in the presence of no fewer than three witnesses.
- The Prescott Group Society staff member that is responsible for the cards will not have any tickets in the draw. They will roll up sleeves or wear short sleeves and show their empty hands before and after handling the cards.
- Cards will be shuffled, spread out on the table and mixed sufficiently. The deck will not be cut. The table used for the jackpot will be large enough to ensure that all cards can be spread out in a manner whereby all cards are visible and available to be selected.
- The winning ticket holder or the Prescott Group Society proxy will put **one** finger on their selected card. They will hold their finger on this card as the Prescott Group Society staff member removes all surrounding cards.

- If in rare occasion there is more than one card underneath, the Prescott Group Society staff member will have the ticket winner select one of the remaining cards and the unselected card(s) will be removed prior to revealing the selected card.
 - Once all surrounding cards are removed, the selected card will be turned over by the Prescott Group Society staff member.
 - If the jackpot card (Ace of Spades) is selected, the winner will receive the full jackpot.
 - If the jackpot card (Ace of Spades) is not selected, there will be a record completed that details the draw date, complete card details and who destroyed it. Once logged, the selected card will be destroyed immediately. This record is available to be viewed by anyone who requests to see them.
 - If the jackpot card (Ace of Spades) is not selected, it must be displayed after the draw to show that it was in the deck.
10. The winner of the Chase the Ace Ticket Draw and the Chase the Ace Jackpot Draw will be contacted using the information listed on their stub ticket. Their winnings will be made available within two business days and will be issued by cheque. A specific time and location will be determined between Prescott Group Society and the winner to collect their cheque. The winner will need to show government issued identification to pick up the cheque.
 11. Each of the weekly winners and the jackpot winner will automatically be deemed to grant to Prescott Group Society an irrevocable right to publish, through all types of media broadcasting, including the internet, for the purposes of promoting the win, their full name and photograph without any claim for broadcasting, printing or other rights. A list of winners will be announced and used publicly by the Prescott Group Society for publicity and/or advertising.
 12. The Prescott Group Society will notify, in writing, to officials from Nova Scotia Alcohol, Gaming, Fuel and Tobacco once the jackpot reaches \$50,000 so they can provide additional support and oversight.
 13. The Prescott Group Society will appoint a chartered accountant to provide ongoing oversight if the Chase the Ace is larger than \$50,000.
 14. A copy of these general house rules will be available wherever tickets are sold.
